want be blured in the coast...


Several patios appear like 'evaporation areas' in the primitive salt mines, and the new interior spaces are planing around this patios.

'The coast like meeting point between the emerged and immersed land...a fragile border stretching, hiding behind the land, raising and sliding...this is the continuos change of the coast.'
























